

Consent to Disclosure of Tax Return Information

Federal law requires this consent form be provided to you ("you" refers to each taxpayer, if more than one). Unless authorized by law, we cannot disclose, without your consent, your tax return information to third parties for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your tax return. If you consent to the disclosure of your tax return information, Federal law may not protect your tax return information from further use or distribution.

You are not required to complete this form to engage our tax return preparation services. If we obtain your signature on this form by conditioning our tax return preparation services on your consent, your consent will not be valid. If you agree to the disclosure of your tax return information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year from the date of signature.

You have indicated that you are interested in applying for a Refund Transfer ("RT") product from Civista Bank and an RT processor, Santa Barbara Tax Products Group, LLC (collectively, "Processor"). In order to have your refund processed by and through Processor, we must disclose all of your 2016 tax return information to BANK and Processor.

If you would like us to disclose your 2016 tax return information to Processor for this purpose, please sign and date your consent to the disclosure of your tax return information.

By signing below, you (including each of you if there is more than one taxpayer) authorize us to disclose to Processor all of your 2016 tax return information so that Processor can evaluate and process your application. You understand that if you are not willing to authorize us to share your tax information with Processor, you will not be able to obtain this service from Processor, but you can still choose to pay us directly to have your tax return prepared and filed.
