

Breaking News! California E-file Update

The California Franchise Tax Board announced they will no longer require a separate registration application to e-file CA individual or business tax returns. When you are approved for the IRS e-file program, you will be automatically enrolled in the California e-file program. California will also automatically update your information when you make changes to your IRS account. To verify your enrollment once you are an approved IRS e-file participant, contact California's e-Programs Customer Service at (916) 845-0353.

Requirements:

- Apply for acceptance in the IRS e-file program. The California FTB receives confirmation from the IRS once they accept you into the program.
- Use your IRS-assigned Electronic Filer Identification Number (EFIN), or Electronic Transmitter Identification Number (ETIN) if you are a transmitter, to e-file with FTB.
- Comply with the guidelines in FTB Publication 1345 [2006 e-file Handbook for Authorized e-file Providers](#) and FTB Publication 1345B [Business e-file Handbook for Authorized e-file Providers of California Business Returns](#).
